ORDER OF THE BOARD

On this day, the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, accepted the voluntary surrender of Vocational Nurse License Number 62255, issued to RAE LYNNE SUGGS, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is currently licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.
2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing.
3. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from Hopkins County Hospital School of Vocational Nursing, Sulphur Springs, Texas, on September 9, 1974. Respondent was licensed to practice Vocational nursing in the State of Texas on November 28, 1974.
4. Respondent's vocational nursing employment history includes:

1974 - 1980	Employment history unknown.
1980 - 1988	LVN San Marcos Baptist Academy San Marcos, Texas

Respondent's vocational nursing employment history continued:

5. On November 5, 2010, the Board provided notice to Respondent for the following allegations:
 - a. On or about August 25, 2010, while employed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse with Hunt Regional Healthcare, Greenville, Texas, Respondent lacked fitness to practice vocational nursing, in that her responses were slower than normal and she had hostile outbursts.
 - b. On or about August 25, 2010, while employed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse with Hunt Regional Healthcare, Greenville, Texas, Respondent engaged in the intemperate use of Propoxyphene, in that she produced a specimen for a random drug screen requested by the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN), which resulted positive for Propoxyphene. Additionally, she admitted to taking her husband's Darvocet.
6. On May 17, 2011, the Board received a notarized statement from Respondent voluntarily surrendering the right to practice nursing in Texas. A copy of Respondent's notarized statement, dated May 13, 2011, is attached and incorporated herein by reference as part of this Order.

7. The Board policy implementing Rule 213.29 in effect on the date of this Agreed Order provides discretion by the Executive Director for consideration of conditional reinstatement after proof of twelve (12) consecutive months of abstinence from alcohol and drugs followed by licensure limitations/stipulations and/or peer assistance program participation.
8. The Board finds that there exists serious risks to public health and safety as a result of impaired nursing care due to intemperate use of controlled substances.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove a violations of Section 301.452(b)(9),(10),(12) &(13), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§217.11(1)(B) and 217.12(1)(A),(E),(4),(5),(9),(10)(A),(D)&(11)(B).
4. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
5. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
6. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.452 (b), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TAC §§213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

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ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the voluntary surrender of Vocational Nurse License Number 62255, heretofore issued to RAE LYNNE SUGGS, to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Executive Director on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice vocational nursing, use the title of vocational nurse or the abbreviation "LVN" or wear any insignia identifying herself as a vocational nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a vocational nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until: one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order; and, RESPONDENT has obtained objective, verifiable proof of twelve (12) consecutive months of sobriety immediately preceding the petition.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.




