ORDER OF THE BOARD

TO: Michael Donald Wiggins

During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on Tuesday, May 10, 2011, the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case, based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee of the Texas Board of Nursing finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the

proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This Order will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing [22 TEX. ADMIN.CODE § 213.16(j)]. All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.

All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Permanent Certificate Number 183537, previously issued to Michael Donald Wiggins, to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is hereby, REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, MICHAEL DONALD WIGGINS, is a Vocational Nurse holding license number 183537, which is in delinquent status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about October 1, 2003, Respondent voluntarily relinquished his license to practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse in the State of Florida. A copy of the Florida Board of Nursing Final Order, dated October 1, 2003 is attached and incorporated, by reference, as part of this pleading.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code.

CHARGE II.

On or about January 2, 2004, Respondent plead Nolo Contendere to three (3) counts of LEWD OR LASCIVIOUS CONDUCT, a Second Degree Felony Offense, in the Circuit Court of the 1st Judicial Circuit, Santa Rosa County, Florida, under case number 03000376CFMA. Subsequently, Respondent received ten (10) years imprisonment in the Florida Department of Corrections for counts 1 and 2, and fifteen (15) years probation for count 3, terms to run consecutively.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Sections 53.021 and 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 Tex. Admin. Code §217.12 (1)(B)&(13).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 213.27 - 213.33, and TEX. OCC. CODE Ch. 53. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to Section 301.461, Texas Occupations Code. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).



FINAL ORDER

Respondent, MICHAEL DONALD WIGGINS, L.P.N., holds Florida license number PN 1222611 as a Licensed Practical Nurse.

In order to avoid further administrative proceedings, the Respondent has submitted a Petition for Voluntary Relinquishment of License which is attached to and made a part of this Final Order.

This cause came before the Board of Nursing at a duly-noticed public meeting on August 15, 2003, in Tallahassee, Florida for final agency action.

The Board, upon review of the Administrative Complaint, the investigative file supplied by the prosecuting attorney, and the admissions in Respondent's petition accepts as its findings of fact those found in the investigative file.

The foregoing facts constitute violations of Sections 456.072(1)(u), 464.017, 464.018(1)(h), (n), Florida Statutes, for which the Board may impose discipline pursuant to Section 464.018(2), Florida Statutes.

The Board has considered Respondent's Petition for Voluntary Relinquishment and concludes it is appropriate. It is therefore ORDERED that the voluntary relinquishment of the

license of MICHAEL DONALD WIGGINS is accepted, subject to the right to reapply for licensure, if any, set forth in the petition.

This Final Order shall become effective upon filing with the Clerk of the Department of Health.




The Respondent authorizes the Board to review and examine all materials contained in the investigative file before, or in conjunction with, consideration of this relinquishment.
