**ORDER OF THE BOARD**

During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on Tuesday, March 8, 2011, the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case, based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee of the Texas Board of Nursing finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the

proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This Order will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing [22 TEX. ADMIN.CODE § 213.16(j)]. All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.

All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.



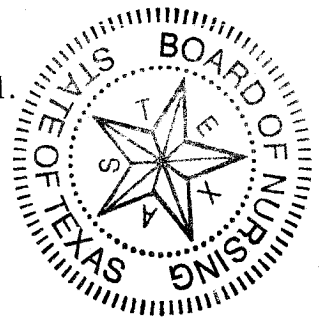

### **FORMAL CHARGES**

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, HOLLY CHRISTINE STEELE, is a Vocational Nurse holding license number 155463, which is in delinquent status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

#### **CHARGE I.**

On or about January 12, 2005, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty and was convicted of EVADING ARREST OR DETENTION (VEHICLE) (a State Jail Felony offense committed on July 20, 2004), in the 75th Judicial District Court, Liberty County, Texas, under Cause No. CR25204. Respondent was sentenced to confinement in the State Jail Division-Texas Department Criminal Justice for a period of one hundred eighty (180) days. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to pay a fine and court costs.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, (eff. date 09/01/2003), and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13)(eff. after 9/28/2004).

#### **CHARGE II.**

On or about July 10, 2006, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty and was convicted of POSSESSION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, NAMELY: COCAINE LESS THAN ONE GRAM (a State Jail Felony offense committed on July 6, 2006), in the 182nd District Court, Harris County, Texas, under Case No. 1075618. Respondent was sentenced to confinement in the Harris County Jail for a period of sixty (60) days. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to pay court costs.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, (eff. date 09/01/2005), and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13)(eff. after 9/28/2004).

### CHARGE III.

On or about November 5, 2008, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty and was convicted of POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE PG 3<28 GRAMS (a Class A misdemeanor offense committed on November 5, 2008), in the County Criminal Court At Law No. 13, Harris County, Texas, under Cause No. 1559976. Respondent was sentenced to confinement in the Harris County Jail for a period of twenty (20) days. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to pay court costs.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, (eff. date 09/01/2007), and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).

### CHARGE IV.

On or about April 30, 2009, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty and was convicted of UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, NAMELY: COCAINE IN AN AMOUNT OF LESS THAN ONE GRAM (a Class A misdemeanor offense committed on January 12, 2009), in the 344th District Court, Chambers County, Texas, under Cause No. Case No. 15123. Respondent was sentenced to confinement in the Chambers County Jail for a period of six (6) months.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, (eff. date 09/01/2007), and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Board's rules, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 213.27 - 213.33 and TEX. OCC. CODE Ch. 53. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to Section 301.461, Texas Occupations Code. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).


