ORDER OF THE BOARD

On this day, the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, accepted the voluntary surrender of Registered Nurse License Number 732020 and Vocational Nurse License Number 189549, issued to WALTER DEAN MCFALL, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is currently licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas. Respondent holds a license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas, which is currently in Delinquent status.
2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing.
3. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from Paris Junior College, Paris, Texas, on May 9, 2003. Respondent was licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas on July 23, 2003. Respondent received an Associate Degree in Nursing from Paris Junior College, Paris, Texas, on May 12, 2006. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on July 25, 2006.

4. Respondent's vocational and professional nursing employment history includes:

5. On or about April 23, 2010, Respondent was issued an Agreed Order by the Texas Board of Nursing, which required him to participate and successfully complete the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN). A copy of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order dated April 23, 2010, is attached and incorporated herein by reference as part of this Order.
6. Formal Charges were filed on December 30, 2010. A copy of the Formal Charges is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this Order.
7. Formal Charges were mailed to Respondent on January 3, 2011.
8. On January 18, 2011, the Board received a signed statement from Respondent voluntarily surrendering the right to practice nursing in Texas. A copy of Respondent's signed statement, dated January 18, 2011, is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this Order.
9. The Board policy implementing Rule 213.29 in effect on the date of this Agreed Order provides discretion by the Executive Director for consideration of conditional reinstatement after proof of twelve (12) consecutive months of abstinence from alcohol and drugs followed by licensure limitations/stipulations and/or peer assistance program participation.
10. The Board finds that there exists serious risks to public health and safety as a result of impaired nursing care due to intemperate use of controlled substances or chemical dependency.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violations of Section 301.452(b)(1)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(9)&(11)(B).
4. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
5. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
6. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.452 (b), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TAC §§213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

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ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the voluntary surrender of Registered Nurse License Number 732020 and Vocational Nurse License Number 189549, heretofore issued to WALTER DEAN MCFALL, to practice professional and vocational nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Executive Director on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice professional or vocational nursing, use the title of "registered nurse" or "vocational nurse" or the abbreviation "RN" or "LVN" or wear any insignia identifying himself as a registered or vocational nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a registered or vocational nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until: one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.



FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, WALTER DEAN MCFALL, is a Vocational Nurse holding license number 189549, which is in Delinquent status at the time of this pleading, and a Registered Nurse holding license number 732020, which is in Current status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about September 14, 2010, Respondent failed to comply with the Agreed Order issued to him by the Texas Board of Nursing on April 23, 2010. Respondent's non-compliance is the result of his failure to comply with Stipulation Number Three (3) of the Order, which states in pertinent part:

RESPONDENT SHALL comply with all requirements of the TPAPN participation agreement during its term...

On September 17, 2010, Respondent was dismissed from TPAPN and referred to the Board.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(1)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(9)&(11)(B).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Board's rules, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 213.27 - 213.33. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to Section 301.461, Texas Occupations Code. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that all statutes and rules cited in these Charges are incorporated as part of this pleading and can be found at the Board's website, www.bon.state.tx.us.



On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of WALTER DEAN MCFALL, Registered Nurse License Number 732020 and Vocational Nurse License Number 189549, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

Information received by the Board produced evidence that Respondent may have violated Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order offered on March 9, 2010, by Katherine A. Thomas, MN, RN, Executive Director.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was served on Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license.
2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent is currently licensed to practice professional in the State of Texas. Respondent holds a license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas, which is in Delinquent status.
4. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from Paris Junior College, Paris, Texas, on May 9, 2003. Respondent was licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas on July 23, 2003. Respondent received an Associate Degree in Nursing from Paris Junior College, Paris, Texas, on May 12, 2006. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on July 25, 2006.

5. Respondent's vocational and professional nursing employment history includes:

6. On or about January 8, 2009, Respondent entered a plea of "Guilty" and was convicted of EVADING ARREST/DETENTION (a Class B misdemeanor offense committed on October 24, 2008), under Cause No. CR0826331, RESIST ARREST SEARCH OR TRANSPORT (a Class A misdemeanor offense committed on October 24, 2008), under Cause No. CR0826332, and ASSAULT CAUSES BODILY INJURY FAMILY MEMBER (a Class A misdemeanor offense committed on October 24, 2008), under Cause No. CR0926351, in the County Court, Sulphur Springs, Texas. As a result of the convictions, Respondent was sentenced to three (3) months confinement with time served. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to pay a fine and court costs.
7. In response to Finding of Fact Number Six (6), Respondent states: My wife and I were separated on October 24, 2008. Later this same day, my now ex-wife stole my recently deceased mother's car, her life insurance paperwork, and my checkbook and debit card from Greenville (Hunt County) and took them to Brashear (Hopkins County). I went to Brashear to get these things back, but she refused to return them. I grabbed her shoulder and threatened her for stealing my mother's things and my things. She then said she would return the items to me, but wanted me to wait outside the house. Once I was outside, she again refused to return the stolen items and called the police claiming that I had choked her. I was going towards the backyard when the police showed up. They said that they were there to arrest me and when I got to the front yard, I was placed in handcuffs.
8. On or about January 16, 2009, Respondent entered a plea of "Guilty" and was convicted of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED 2ND OFFENSE (a Class A misdemeanor offense committed on August 10, 2008), in the County Court at Law of Hunt County, Texas, under Cause No. CR0801883. As a result of the conviction, Respondent was sentenced to 250 days confinement in the Hunt County Jail, and ordered to pay a fine and court cost.

9. In response to Finding of Fact Number Eight (8), Respondent states: In regard to my DWI 2nd, I plead guilty because I was indeed guilty. The only family I had, my mother, had recently passed away. I was not working at the time, and I was on an emotional roller coaster, but I should not have driven after I'd been drinking alcohol. I reacted wrongly to a bad situation. I am no longer drinking and am going to AA regularly.
10. The Respondent's conduct described in the preceding Findings of Fact was reportable under the provisions of Sections 301.401-301.419, Texas Occupations Code.
11. The Board finds that there exists serious risks to public health and safety as a result of impaired nursing care due to intemperate use of controlled substances or chemical dependency.
12. Respondent's conduct described in Finding of Fact Number Eight (8) resulted from Respondent's impairment by dependency on alcohol.
13. Respondent's compliance with the terms of a Board approved peer assistance program should be sufficient to protect patients and the public.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.455, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violations of Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).
4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Registered Nurse License Number 732020 and Vocational Nurse License Number 189549, heretofore issued to WALTER DEAN MCFALL, including revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
5. The Board may, in its discretion, order a nurse to participate in a peer assistance program approved by the Board if the nurse would otherwise have been eligible for referral to peer assistance pursuant to Section 301.410, Texas Occupations Code.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED and ORDERED that RESPONDENT, in lieu of the sanction of Revocation under Section 301.453, Texas Occupations Code, SHALL comply with the following conditions for such a time as is required for RESPONDENT to successfully complete the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN):

(1) RESPONDENT SHALL, within forty-five (45) days following the date of entry of this final Order, apply to TPAPN and SHALL, within ninety (90) days following the date of entry of this final Order, sign and execute the TPAPN participation agreement, which SHALL include payment of a non-refundable participation fee in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) payable to TPAPN.

(2) Upon acceptance into the TPAPN, RESPONDENT SHALL waive confidentiality and provide a copy of the executed TPAPN participation agreement to the Texas Board of Nursing.

(3) RESPONDENT SHALL comply with all requirements of the TPAPN participation agreement during its term and SHALL keep his license to practice nursing in the State of Texas current.

(4) RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE the TPAPN to notify the Texas Board of Nursing of any violation of the TPAPN participation agreement.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED, RESPONDENT SHALL comply in all respects with the Nursing Practice Act, Texas Occupations Code, Section §§301.001 *et seq.*, the Rules and Regulations Relating to Nurse Education, Licensure and Practice, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §211.1 *et seq.* and this Order.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that while Respondent's license is encumbered by this Order, Respondent may not work outside the State of Texas pursuant to a multistate licensure privilege without the written permission of the Texas Board of Nursing and the Board of Nursing in the party state where Respondent wishes to work.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, SHOULD RESPONDENT fail to comply with this Order or the terms of the participation agreement with the TPAPN, such noncompliance will result in further disciplinary action including EMERGENCY SUSPENSION pursuant to Section 301.4551, Texas Occupations Code, or REVOCATION of Respondent's license and nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

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RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION

I understand that I have the right to legal counsel prior to signing this Agreed Order. I waive representation by counsel. I have reviewed this Order. I neither admit nor deny the violations alleged herein. I do acknowledge possessing a diagnosis that deems me eligible to participate in the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses. By my signature on this Order, I agree to the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Conditions One (1) through Four (4) of this Order to obtain disposition of the allegations through peer assistance and to avoid further disciplinary action in this matter. I waive judicial review of this Order. I understand that this Order becomes effective upon acceptance by the Executive Director on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing, and a copy will be mailed to me. I understand that if I fail to comply with all terms and conditions of this Order, I will be subject to investigation and disciplinary sanction, including revocation of my license to practice professional and vocational nursing in the State of Texas, as a consequence of my noncompliance.

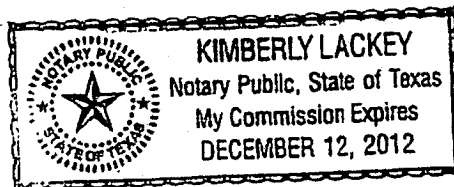
