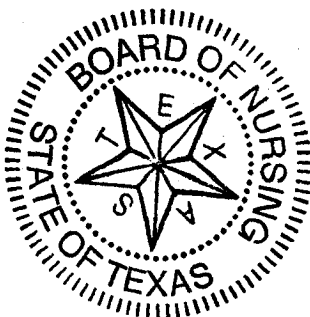

On the 9th day of June, 2009, the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee of the Board of Nurse Examiners met at the Board's office at 333 Guadalupe, Austin, Texas. Richard Gibbs, LVN; and Marilyn Davis, RN, BSN. Staff present were Katherine A.
