ORDER OF THE BOARD

On this day, the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, accepted the voluntary surrender of Registered Nurse License Number 708653, issued to CELESTE RENEE PADGETT, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal conference, notice and hearing.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds a license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas which is currently in delinquent status.
2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal conference, notice and hearing.
3. Respondent received an Associate Degree in Nursing from Tarrant County Junior College, Fort Worth, Texas, on May 14, 2004. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on August 3, 2004.

4. Respondent's professional nursing employment history includes:

5. Formal Charges were filed on February 14, 2008. A copy of the Formal Charges is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this Order.
6. Formal Charges were mailed to Respondent on February 15, 2008.
7. On October 10, 2008, Respondent submitted a notarized statement to the Board voluntarily surrendering the right to practice professional nursing in Texas.
8. The Board policy implementing Rule 213.29 in effect on the date of this Agreed Order provides discretion by the Executive Director for consideration of conditional reinstatement after proof of twelve (12) consecutive months of abstinence from alcohol and drugs followed by licensure limitations/stipulations and/or peer assistance program participation.
9. The Board finds that there exists serious risks to public health and safety as a result of impaired nursing care due to intemperate use of controlled substances or chemical dependency.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violations of Section 301.452(b)(10),(12)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 217.11(1)(A),(B),(C)&(D) and 217.12(1)(A),(C)&(E),(4),(5),(6)(G),(10)(B)(C)&(11)(B).
4. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
5. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
6. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.452 (b), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TAC §§ 213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the voluntary surrender of Registered Nurse License Number 708653, heretofore issued to CELESTE RENEE PADGETT, to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Executive Director on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice professional nursing, use the title of "registered nurse" or the abbreviation "RN" or wear any insignia identifying herself as a registered nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a registered nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until: one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order; and, RESPONDENT has obtained objective, verifiable proof of twelve (12) consecutive months of sobriety immediately preceding the petition.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's multistate licensure privilege, if any, to practice professional nursing in compact states.

FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, CELESTE RENEE PADGETT, is a Registered Nurse holding license number 708653, which is in Current status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about May 6, 2006 to May 15, 2006, while employed Harris Methodist Forth Worth Hospital, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent withdrew Demerol (Meperidine) from the Pyxis Medication Dispensing System for patients and administered the medications in excess frequency of the physician's orders, as follows:

Respondent's conduct was likely to injure the patients in that the administration of Demerol in excess frequency of the physician's order could result in the patients suffering from adverse effects.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§217.11(1)(A),(B)&(C) and 217.12(1)(A)&(11)(B).

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CHARGE II.

On or about April 30, 2006 to May 15, 2006, while employed with Harris Methodist Fort Worth Hospital, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent withdrew medications from the Pyxis Medication Dispensing System for patients, but failed to accurately and completely document the administration of this medication in the patients' Medication Administration Record and/or Nurses Notes, as follows:

Respondent's conduct was likely to injure the patients in that subsequent care givers would rely on her documentation to further medicate the patients which could result in an overdose and placed the hospital in violation of Chapter 481 of the Texas Health and Safety Code (Controlled Substances Act).

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§217.11(1)(A),(B),(C)&(D) and 217.12(1)(A),(4),(10)(B)&(11)(B).

CHARGE III.

On or about May 14 and 15, 2006, while employed with Harris Methodist Fort Worth Hospital, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent withdrew Demerol 50mg from the Pyxis Medication Dispensing System for Patient Medical Record Number 34486079001 without a valid physician's order, as follows:

Respondent's conduct resulted in an inaccurate medical record and was likely to injure the patient in that the administration of Demerol without a physician's order could result in the patient suffering from adverse reactions.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§217.11(1)(A)&(C) and 217.12(1)(A)&(11)(B).

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CHARGE IV.

On or about April 30, 2006 to May 15, 2006, while employed with Harris Methodist Fort Worth Hospital, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent withdrew medications from the Pyxis Medication Dispensing System for patients, but failed to follow the facility's policy and procedure for wastage of the unused portions of the medications, as follows:

Respondent's conduct was likely to deceive the hospital pharmacy and placed them in violation of Chapter 481 of the Texas Health and Safety Code (Controlled Substances Act).

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§217.11(1)(A)&(D) and 217.12(1)(A),(10)(B)(C),&(11)(B).

CHARGE V.

On or about April 30, 2006 to May 15, 2006, while employed with Harris Methodist Fort Worth Hospital, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent misappropriated, and/or failed to take precautions to prevent the misappropriation of medications belonging to the facility and patients thereof. Respondent's conduct was likely to defraud the facility and patients of the cost of the medications.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(6)(G).

CHARGE VI.

On or about April 30, 2006 to May 15, 2006, while employed with Harris Methodist Fort Worth Hospital, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent lacked fitness to practice professional nursing in that she was observed sleeping while on duty. Respondent's condition could have affected her ability to recognize subtle signs, symptoms or changes in the patients' conditions, and could have affected her ability to make rational, accurate, and appropriate assessments, judgments, and decisions regarding patient care, thereby placing the patients in potential danger.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(12), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(4)&(5).

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CHARGE VII.

On or about August 31, 2006, while employed with Nursefinders, Inc., Fort Worth, Texas, and on assignment with Huguley Memorial Medical Center, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent withdrew medications from the Pyxis Medication Dispensing System for patients, but failed to accurately and completely document the administration of this medication in the patients' Medication Administration Record and/or Nurses Notes, as follows:

Respondent's conduct was likely to injure the patients in that subsequent care givers would rely on her documentation to further medicate the patients which could result in an overdose and placed the hospital in violation of Chapter 481 of the Texas Health and Safety Code (Controlled Substances Act).

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§217.11(1)(A)&(D) and 217.12(1)(A)&(C),(10)(B)&(11)(B).

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CHARGE VIII.

On or about August 31, 2006, while employed with Nursefinders, Inc., Fort Worth, Texas, and on assignment with Huguley Memorial Medical Center, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent withdrew medications from the Pyxis Medication Dispensing System for patients, but failed to follow the facility's policy and procedure for wastage of the unused portions of the medications, as follows:

Respondent's conduct was likely to deceive the hospital pharmacy and placed them in violation of Chapter 481 of the Texas Health and Safety Code (Controlled Substances Act).

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§217.11(1)(A)&(D) and 217.12(1)(A),(10)(B)(C), &(11)(B).

CHARGE IX.

On or about August 31, 2006, while employed with Nursefinders, Inc., Fort Worth, Texas, and on assignment with Huguley Memorial Medical Center, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent misappropriated, and/or failed to take precautions to prevent the misappropriation of medications belonging to the facility and patients thereof. Respondent's conduct was likely to defraud the facility and patients of the cost of the medications.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(6)(G).

CHARGE X.

On or about August 31, 2006, while employed with Nursefinders, Inc., Fort Worth, Texas, and on assignment with Huguley Memorial Medical Center, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent lacked fitness to practice professional nursing in that she was observed anxious, agitated and asking inappropriate questions while on duty. Respondent's condition could have affected her ability to recognize subtle signs, symptoms or changes in the patients' conditions, and could have affected her ability to make rational, accurate, and appropriate assessments, judgments, and decisions regarding patient care, thereby placing the patients in potential danger.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(12), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(1)(E),(4)&(5).

CHARGE XI.

On or about August 31, 2006, while employed with Nursefinders, Inc., Fort Worth, Texas, and on assignment with Huguley Memorial Medical Center, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent administered Cefazolin to Patient Medical Record Number 359396 without a valid physician's order. Respondent's conduct was likely to injure the patient in that administration of Cefazolin to a patient without a physician's order could result in the patient suffering from adverse reactions.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(10)&(13), Texas Occupations Code, and is a violation of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§217.11(1)(A),(B)&(C) and 217.12(1)(A)&(4).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Board's rules, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 213.27 - 213.33. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to § 301.461, TEX. OCC. CODE ANN. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).


