BEFORE THE TEXAS BOARD OF NURSING

In the Matter of License Number 689148 § AGREED
issued to SARAH REBECCA TYNDALL § ORDER

On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of SARAH REBECCA TYNDALL, Registered Nurse License Number 689148, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

Information received by the Board produced evidence that Respondent may have violated Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order offered on November 12, 2008, by Katherine A. Thomas, MN, RN, Executive Director.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was served on Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license.
2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent is currently licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.
4. Respondent received a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing from Louisiana State University Medical Center, New Orleans, Louisiana, on May 18, 2002. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on August 1, 2002.
5. Respondent's professional nursing employment history is unknown.

6. On or about October 8, 2008, Respondent submitted a License Renewal Form for Registered Nurses to the Texas Board of Nursing. On the Renewal, Respondent answered "Yes" to the question: "Has any licensing authority. . . reprimanded, or otherwise disciplined you?"

On or about June 23, 2008, Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Louisiana was issued the sanction of a Reprimand and Respondent agreed to accept and abide by a Consent Order offered by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing. A copy of the Findings of Fact and Consent Order, dated June 23, 2008, is attached and incorporated, by reference, as part of this Order.

7. In response to Finding of Fact Number Six (6), Respondent states: The requirements in the Consent Order have been fulfilled and were set to be reviewed by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing (LSBN) at the September Board meeting. According to the LSBN, the September Board meeting was postponed until October due to hurricane evacuations.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation of Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code.
4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Registered Nurse License Number 689148, heretofore issued to SARAH REBECCA TYNDALL, including revocation of Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED and ORDERED, subject to ratification by the Texas Board of Nursing, that RESPONDENT SHALL receive the sanction of REMEDIAL EDUCATION, and RESPONDENT SHALL comply in all respects with the Nursing Practice Act, Texas Occupations Code §§301.001 *et seq.*, the Rules and Regulations Relating to Nurse Education,

Licensure and Practice, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §211.1 *et seq.* and this Order.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's multistate licensure privilege, if any, to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that while Respondent's license is encumbered by this Order, Respondent may not work outside the State of Texas pursuant to a multistate licensure privilege without the written permission of the State of Texas and the Board of Nursing in the party state where Respondent wishes to work.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that:

(1) RESPONDENT SHALL, within one (1) year of entry of this Order, successfully complete a course in Texas nursing jurisprudence and ethics. RESPONDENT SHALL obtain Board approval of the course prior to enrollment only if the course is not being offered by a pre-approved provider. Home study courses and video programs will not be approved. In order for the course to be approved, the target audience shall include nurses. It shall be a minimum of six (6) contact hours in length. The course's content shall include the Nursing Practice Act, standards of practice, documentation of care, principles of nursing ethics, confidentiality, professional boundaries, and the Board's Disciplinary Sanction Policies regarding: Sexual Misconduct; Fraud, Theft and Deception; Nurses with Substance Abuse, Misuse, Substance Dependency, or other Substance Use Disorder; and Lying and Falsification. Courses focusing on malpractice issues will not be accepted. RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE the sponsoring institution to submit a Verification of Course Completion form, provided by the Board, to the Office of the Board to verify RESPONDENT's successful completion of the course. This course shall be taken in addition to any other courses

stipulated in this Order, if any, and in addition to any continuing education requirements the Board has for relicensure. *Board-approved courses may be found at the following Board website address:*

(2) RESPONDENT SHALL fully comply with all the terms and conditions of the Order of the Board issued to SARAH REBECCA TYNDALL on June 23, 2008, by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing. RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE the Louisiana State Board of Nursing to submit quarterly reports, on forms provided by the Texas Board, that SARAH REBECCA TYNDALL is in compliance with the Order of the Board, and RESPONDENT SHALL cause the Louisiana State Board of Nursing to submit written verification of Respondent's successful completion of that Order. Evidence of compliance/completion with the terms of the Order of the Louisiana State Board of Nursing will be accepted as evidence of compliance/completion of the terms of this Order issued by the Texas Board of Nursing.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, that upon full compliance with the terms of this Order, RESPONDENT SHALL be issued an unencumbered license and multistate licensure privileges, if any, to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.

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RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION

I understand that I have the right to legal counsel prior to signing this Agreed Order. I waive representation by counsel. I have reviewed this Order. I neither admit nor deny the violation alleged herein. By my signature on this Order, I agree to the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Order, and any conditions of said Order, to avoid further disciplinary action in this matter. I waive judicial review of this Order. I understand that when this Order becomes final and the terms of this Order become effective, a copy will be mailed to me. I understand that if I fail to comply with all terms and conditions of this Order, I will be subject to investigation and disciplinary sanction, including revocation of my license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas, as a consequence of my noncompliance.


