

6. On or about May 18, 2006, Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Arizona was placed on PROBATION for a period of eighteen (18) months, with conditions, by the Arizona State Board of Nursing, Phoenix, Arizona, based on Findings that:
 - 6.1 On or about January 12, 2004, while employed with Mayo Clinic Hospital in Scottsdale, Arizona, Respondent failed to check the defibrillator to assure that it was charged. She admitted she had been rushed and did not complete the check but told staff she would return to finish. Respondent was unable to interpret the cardiac monitor to assess if a patient had a cardiac arrhythmia. Respondent said she had never completed an EKG course and was not asked about this upon hire.
 - 6.2 On or about April 19, 2004, Respondent was terminated from Mayo Clinic Hospital, Scottsdale, Arizona, for her inability to demonstrate basic nursing skills.
 - 6.3 On or about November 2004, Respondent was terminated from Healthsouth Rehabilitation Plastic Surgery Center, Scottsdale, Arizona for being "scattered."

A copy of the Arizona State Board of Nursing Consent Agreement and Order dated May 18, 2006, is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation of Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code.
4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Registered Nurse License Number 628449, heretofore issued to JANE MARIA PASTORE, including revocation of Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED and ORDERED, subject to ratification by the Board of Nurse Examiners, that RESPONDENT SHALL receive the sanction of a WARNING WITH STIPULATIONS, and RESPONDENT SHALL comply in all respects with the Nursing Practice Act,

Revised Civil Statutes of Texas as amended, Texas Occupations Code, §§301.001 *et seq.*, the Rules and Regulations Relating to Professional Nurse Education, Licensure and Practice, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §211.01 *et seq.* and this Order.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's multistate licensure privilege, if any, to practice professional nursing in compact states.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that:

(1) RESPONDENT SHALL deliver the wallet-sized license issued to JANE MARIA PASTORE, to the office of the Board of Nurse Examiners within ten (10) days from the date of ratification of this Order for appropriate notation.

(2) RESPONDENT SHALL fully comply with all the terms and conditions of the Order of the Board issued to JANE MARIA PASTORE on May 18, 2006, by the Arizona State Board of Nursing. RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE the Arizona State Board of Nursing to submit quarterly reports, on forms provided by the Texas Board, confirming that JANE MARIA PASTORE is in compliance with the Order of the Board, and RESPONDENT SHALL cause the Arizona State Board of Nursing to submit written verification of Respondent's successful completion of that Order. Evidence of compliance/completion with the terms of the Order of the Arizona State State Board of Nursing will be accepted as evidence of compliance/completion of the terms of this Order issued by the Board of Nurse Examiners for the State of Texas.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, that upon full compliance with the terms of this Order, RESPONDENT SHALL be issued an unencumbered license and multistate licensure privileges, if any, to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.


RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION
