issued to ANGELA MARIE JACKSON § ORDER

An investigation by the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, produced evidence indicating that ANGELA MARIE JACKSON, hereinafter referred to as Respondent, Vocational Nurse License Number 170616, may have violated Section 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code.

An informal conference was held on April 1, 2008, at the office of the Texas Board of Nursing, in accordance with Section 301.464, Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent appeared in person. Respondent was represented by Lowell Scott Kendall, Attorney at Law. In attendance were Katherine A. Thomas, MN, RN, Executive Director; Joy Sparks, Assistant General Counsel; Anthony L. Diggs, MSCJ, Director, Enforcement Division; and Scott Torres, Investigator.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was served on Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license.
2. Respondent waived notice and hearing, and consented to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent is currently licensed to practice vocational nursing in Texas.
4. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from St. Phillip's College, San Antonio, Texas, on December 10, 1998. Respondent was licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas on January 21, 1999.
5. Respondent's vocational nursing employment history includes:

On or about August 25, 2005, Respondent entered a plea of Nolo Contendere to THEFT \$20 - \$500 - CHECK (a Class B misdemeanor offense committed August 15, 2003), in the County Court at Law No. 4 of Bexar County, Texas, under Cause No. 896299. As a result, the proceedings against Respondent were deferred without entering an adjudication of guilt, and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of six (6) months. In addition, Respondent was ordered to pay court costs.
7. On or about October 30, 2006, Respondent was arrested by the Bexar County Sheriff, San Antonio, Texas, and subsequently charged under Cause No. 984376 with THEFT OF PROPERTY > = \$20 < \$500 BY CHECK (a Class B misdemeanor offense committed on July 31, 2005). On or about December 11, 2007, Cause No. 984376 was dismissed based on Respondent's plea entered in Cause No. 2006CR2504.

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8. On or about November 30, 2006, Respondent entered a plea of Nolo Contendere to CREDIT/DEBIT CARD ABUSE (a State Jail felony offense committed on April 25, 2005), in the 379th Judicial District Court of Bexar County, Texas, under Cause No. 2006CR2504. As a result, the proceedings against Respondent were deferred without entering an adjudication of guilt, and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to pay restitution in the amount of one hundred twenty- four dollars and ninety-three cents (\$124.93). Furthermore, Respondent was ordered to pay a fine and court costs.
9. Respondent, by her signature to this Order, expresses her desire to voluntarily surrender her license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violations of Section 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).
4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against License Number 170616, heretofore issued to ANGELA MARIE JACKSON, including revocation of Respondent's vocational license to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
5. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
6. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
7. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

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ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED and ORDERED, that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Vocational Nurse License Number 170616, heretofore issued to ANGELA MARIE JACKSON to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL immediately deliver the wallet-sized license, heretofore issued to ANGELA MARIE JACKSON, to the office of the Texas Board of Nursing.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice vocational nursing, use the title "vocational nurse" or the abbreviation "LVN" or wear any insignia identifying herself as a vocational nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a vocational nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
3. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
4. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's multistate licensure privilege, if any, to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.


