ORDER OF THE BOARD

During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on June 10, 2008, the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case. This case was heard, and based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee of the Texas Board of Nursing finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This Order will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing (22 TEX. ADMIN.CODE § 213.2(j)). All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.

All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Permanent Certificate Number 193717, previously issued to ANITA MARIE JOHNSON, to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is hereby, REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Permanent Certificate Number 193717, previously issued to ANITA MARIE JOHNSON, upon receipt of this Order, be immediately delivered to the office of the Texas Board of Nursing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's multi-state privilege, if any, to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

CHARGE III.

On or about January 20, 2004, Respondent's license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Wisconsin was Suspended by the Wisconsin Department of Regulations & Licensing, Board of Nursing, Madison, Wisconsin. A copy of the Order Suspending License dated March 7, 2003, is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this pleading.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 302.402(a)(7), Texas Occupations Code.

CHARGE IV.

On or about August 22, 2005, Respondent's license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Illinois was Indefinitely Suspended by the Department of Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois, Chicago, Illinois. A copy of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Recommendation to the Director, and Order of the Board dated August 22, 2005, is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this pleading.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Board's rules, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 213.27 - 213.33. and TEX. OCC. CODE Ch. 53. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to § 301.461, TEX. OCC. CODE ANN. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1200.00).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that all statutes and rules cited in these Charges are incorporated as part of this pleading and can be found at the Board's website, www.bon.state.tx.us.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that to the extent applicable, based on the Formal Charges, the Board will rely on Adopted Disciplinary Sanction Policies for Nurses with Lying and Falsification and Fraud, Theft & Deception which can be found at the Board's website, www.bon.state.tx.us.





FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
AND RECOMMENDATION TO THE DIRECTOR

Now comes the Illinois Board of Nursing for the Division of Professional Regulation of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois and, after reviewing the record in this matter, a majority of its members hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation to the Director:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. THAT Respondent, Leslie Brandon n/k/a Anita Johnson is now a duly licensed Licensed Practical Nurse in the State of Illinois, having been issued a certificate of Registration, License No. 043-057457, by the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation. Respondent's license is in expired status.
2. THAT the Department filed a Complaint against the Respondent and sent notice of the Preliminary Hearing with the Complaint to the Respondent by certified and regular mail, to the last known address of the Respondent: P.O. Box 133012, Dallas, Texas. The Preliminary Hearing was set for August 2, 2004.

3. THAT on August 2, 2004 the Respondent failed to appear, either in person or by counsel. The Respondent had not filed an Answer.

4. THAT the Administrative Law Judge ordered that Respondent file an Answer to the Department's Complaint on or before September 3, 2004. A second Order to Answer for December 10, 2004 was entered on November 8, 2004 due to the Respondent's name change and verification thereof. A Status Hearing was set for February 7, 2005. The Administrative Law Judge's Order warned the Respondent that the failure to file an Answer would result in the Respondent being held in default and that the matter would then be sent to the Board on the pleadings. A copy of the Administrative Law Judge's Order was sent by certified and regular mail to the last known address of the Respondent.

5. THAT on February 7, 2005 the Respondent failed to appear, either in person or by counsel. The Respondent had not filed an Answer. The Respondent was held in Default.

6. THAT on February 7, 2005 the Administrative Law Judge transferred the matter to this Board for its deliberation on the pleadings. A copy of the Administrative Law Judge's Order was sent by certified and regular mail to the last known address of the Respondent.

7. THAT this Board finds the allegations of the Complaint to be true:

a. Respondent's license was suspended by the State of Wisconsin for failure to complete three continuing education courses in the area of confidentiality and patients' rights.

b. Respondent tested positive in a pre-employment screen for marijuana on December 12, 2003.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. THAT the Illinois Board of Nursing for the Division of Professional Regulation of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties in this case.
2. THAT the Respondent's Sister State Discipline is a sufficient ground for discipline pursuant to 225 ILCS 65/10-45(b)10
3. THAT the Respondent's positive test for marijuana in a pre-employment screen is sufficient ground for discipline pursuant to 225 ILCS 65/10-45(b)7.

RECOMMENDATION

The Illinois Board of Nursing for the Division of Professional Regulation of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois, after making the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, recommends to the Director of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, that the Certificate of Registration, Registered Professional Nurse, License No. 043-057457, of Leslie Brandon n/k/a Anita Johnson be Indefinitely Suspended.

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Leslie Anne Brandon (D.O.B. 03/19/1957) is duly licensed as a practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license #303265). This license was first granted on 07/13/2001.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 6235 7th Avenue, Apt. 208, Kenosha, WI 53143. Respondent's latest address known to the Division of Enforcement is PO Box 416, Zion, IL 60099.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a licensed practical nurse at Washington Manor ["Washington Manor"], 3100 Washington Road, Kenosha, Wisconsin.

4. On or about November 25, 2001, Respondent informed a family member of a (post CVA) adult resident of Washington Manor that the resident had contracted a sexually transmitted disease while out on pass.

5. Respondent did not have the resident's permission to release this information, and the family member did not have authority to require provision of health care information about the resident.

6. For the purpose of resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to issuance of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to sec. 441.07, Stats.

2. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Stats.

3. By the conduct described above, Leslie Anne Brandon is subject to disciplinary action against her Wisconsin nursing license, pursuant to sec. 441.07(1), Wis. Stats., and Wis. Admin. Code § N7.04 (10) and (15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Wisconsin nursing license of Leslie Anne Brandon (license #303265) is **LIMITED** as follows:

Continuing Education

1. Within ninety [90] days from the date of this order, Respondent shall submit acceptable documentation of successful completion of the University of Wisconsin School of Nursing continuing education program entitled "Legal Issues for Nurses in Today's Health Care Environment".
2. Within six [6] months from the date of this order, Respondent shall submit acceptable documentation of successful completion of at least three [3] additional hours of continuing education or of other training pre-approved by the Board in the areas of patient confidentiality and patient rights, or other training pre-approved by the Board.
3. Acceptable documentation of completion of continuing education shall include: certification from the sponsoring organization as well as a statement signed by Respondent verifying her attendance at the course and completion of course requirements.

Termination of limited license status

4. Upon Respondent's full, timely and successful completion of the terms of this Order, the Board shall restore Respondent's license to full and unrestricted status.
5. Respondent shall be responsible for all expenses incurred for training and other reporting as required by this order.

SUMMARY SUSPENSION

6. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may in addition be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license pursuant to the procedures set forth in Wis. Admin. Code RL Ch. 6. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

Effective date of Order

7. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.


It is hereby stipulated between Leslie Anne Brandon, personally on her own behalf; and Steven M. Gloc, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered in resolution of the above-captioned proceedings. This stipulation and Final Decision and Order shall be presented directly to the Board of Nursing for its consideration and adoption.
2. Respondent understands that by the signing of this Stipulation she voluntarily and knowingly waives her rights, including: the right to a hearing on the allegations against her, at which time the state has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against her; the right to call witnesses on her behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena; the right to testify herself; the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision; the right to petition for rehearing; and all other applicable rights afforded to her under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes and the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
3. Respondent is aware of her right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal advice prior to signing this stipulation.
4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Board of Nursing. The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.
5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall be returned to the Division of Enforcement for further proceedings. In the event that this Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this stipulation agree that the attorney or paralegal for the Division of Enforcement and the member of the Board of Nursing assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board for the purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that the members of the Board may have in connection with their deliberations on the stipulation.


7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this stipulation, the Board's final decision and order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedures.

ORDER SUSPENDING LICENSE


