On this day, the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, accepted the voluntary surrender of Registered Nurse License Number 457262, issued to DEBRA LUCILLE BAGGOTT, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c) of the Texas Occupations Code.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was served on Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license.
2. Respondent agreed to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent holds a license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas which is in delinquent status.
4. Respondent received a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing from the University of Maryland Medical System, Baltimore, Maryland, on June 4, 1976. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on March 12, 1981. Respondent received authorization to practice as Nurse Anesthetist by the Board of Nurse Examiners for the State of Texas on September 14, 1992.

6. At the time of the incident in Finding of Fact Number Seven (7), Respondent was employed as a Nurse Anesthetist with Pinnacle /anesthesia, P.A., Fort Worth, Texas, and had been in this position for three (3) years and five (5) months.
7. On or about February 14, 2006, through February 20, 2006, while employed with Pinnacle Anesthesia, PA, and working at Harris Methodist Fort Worth, Fort Worth, Texas, Respondent's use of prescribed pain medications may have adversely affected her behavior at her job as a CRNA on two (2) occasions in 2006. Respondent's condition could have affected her ability to make rational, accurate, and appropriate assessments, judgments, and decisions regarding patient care.
8. The Board finds that there may exist a risk to public health and safety as a result of impaired nursing care.
9. Respondent, by her signature to this Order, states that she does not desire to be licensed and expresses her desire to voluntarily surrender her license to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
10. Respondent agrees to comply with Rule 213.29 in effect on the date of this Agreed Order, or as amended by the Board in the future, in the event Respondent applies for reinstatement of her license.
11. Upon approval of this Agreed Order by the Board, the Board staff will file a motion to dismiss State Office of Administrative Hearings Docket Number 507-08-0121.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. If proven, Finding of Fact Number Seven (7) would be sufficient to state a violation of Section 301.452(b)(12), Texas Occupations Code.
4. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
5. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, as amended, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
6. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED and ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Registered Nurse License Number 457262, heretofore issued to DEBRA LUCILLE BAGGOTT, to practice nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL immediately deliver the wallet-sized license, heretofore issued to DEBRA LUCILLE BAGGOTT, to the office of the Texas Board of Nursing.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice professional nursing, use the title "registered nurse" or the abbreviation "RN" or wear any insignia identifying herself as a registered nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a registered nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
3. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until: one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order;

4. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's multistate privilege, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

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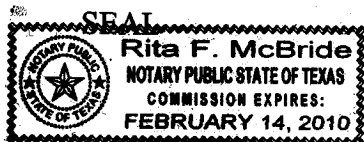
RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION
