On this day came to be considered by the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners for the State of Texas, hereinafter referred to as the Board, the matter of vocational nurse license number 083717, held by PONTIA N. SMITH hereinafter called Respondent.

A sworn Complaint has been filed and served on the Respondent, which alleges violations of the Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 302, and grounds to take disciplinary action against Respondent.

**FIRST AMENDED  
COMPLAINT**

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, a Notary Public in and for the State of Texas, on this day personally appeared Lynda G. Pringle, who after being by me duly sworn, did depose and say:

As an Investigator for the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners, I, Lynda G. Pringle, do hereby present to the Executive Director of the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners, the following complaint against PONTIA N. SMITH, a practitioner of vocational nursing in Texas licensed by the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners with license number 083717, hereinafter called Respondent.

**I.**

a. On or about October 19, 2001, the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners received a referral from the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN) alleging that Respondent had declined participation in their program.

**II.**

a. Respondent was employed as a Licensed Vocational Nurse with Prescription Home Health Agency in San Antonio, Texas from about September 13, 1999 through about September 29, 2000.

b. While so employed with said facility, Respondent accepted nursing assignments when her emotional condition prevented the safe and effective delivery of patient care.

Respondent verbalized threats of suicide to patients and was observed exhibiting unusual behavior, including crying spells and paranoia. Respondent also disclosed confidential information concerning the personal lives of patients to third parties not involved with patient care. As a result of Respondent's mental impairment, the facility subsequently referred Respondent to TPAPN.

c. On or about October 2, 2000, the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners received a referral from the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN) alleging that Respondent had declined participation in their program. However, on or about June 1, 2001, Respondent sent correspondence to the Board office requesting that she be allowed to participate in TPAPN. On or about June 28, 2001, Respondent executed an affidavit in which she acknowledged that she had a mental impairment problem and formally requested to be allowed to participate in TPAPN. However, by letter dated October 19, 2001, the Board was informed that Respondent had again declined participation in their program.

d. Respondent by her actions and admission has demonstrated a lack of fitness to practice vocational nursing because of her impaired mental condition which could result in injury to the public or to herself.

### III.

Furthermore, Respondent failed to timely notify the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners of her change of address in accordance with Board Rule 235.46.

### IV.

The foregoing acts constitute unprofessional or dishonorable conduct that, in the opinion of the Board, is likely to deceive, defraud, or injure the public, in violation of the Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 302, Section 302.402 (a) (10) and Rule 239.11 of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners, Title 22, Texas Administrative Code. Rule 239.11, provides in pertinent part: that "Unprofessional Conduct" shall include, but not be limited to:



- (10) practicing as a vocational nurse holding a license or temporary permit or a graduate making application for licensure, and or applying for employment or by virtue of being an LVN in an Educational program while the individual's ability to practice is impaired by alcohol, drugs, physical or mental disability and/or testing positive for alcohol, illicit drugs, or other substances not prescribed;
- (21) disclosing confidential information or knowledge concerning the patient/client except where required or allowed by law;
- (27) failing to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable prevailing practice, regardless of whether or not actual injury to any person was sustained, including but not limited to:
  - (B) accepting an assignment when one's physical or emotional condition prevents the safe and effective delivery of care or accepting an assignment for which one lacks the educational preparation, experience, knowledge or ability;

V.

Respondent is lacking in fitness to practice as a vocational nurse because of a mental or physical health condition that could result in injury to a patient or the public, in violation of the Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 302, Section 302.402 (a) (12).

VI.

**The foregoing acts constitute grounds for the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners to take disciplinary action as provided under the Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 302, Licensed Vocational Nurse, Section 302.403 and Section 302.451, relief such as revocation, suspension, suspension with probation,**

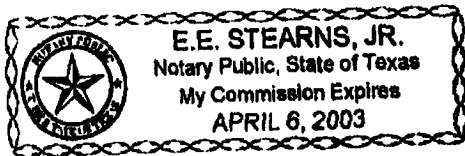
