On this day the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Board, considered the matter of LISA LYNNEL DANNELS, Vocational Nurse License Number 130083, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent waived notice and hearing and agreed to the entry of this Order. The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was served on Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license(s).
2. Respondent waived notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent's license to practice as a vocational nurse in the State of Texas is in current status.
4. Respondent received a Certificate in Vocational Nursing from Wharton County Jr College, Wharton, Texas on August 17, 1990. Respondent was licensed to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas on November 28, 1990.
5. Respondent's vocational nursing employment history is unknown.
6. On or about January 4, 2010, Respondent was issued the an Agreed Order of a Remedial Education by the Texas Board of Nursing. A copy of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Agreed Order dated January 14, 2010, is attached and incorporated, by reference, as part of this Order.

7. Respondent disclosed that on or about August 28, 2013, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty and was convicted of THEFT, a 2nd Degree felony offense committed on May 31, 2006, in the 130th District Court of Matagorda County, Texas, under Cause No. 13-162. As a result of the conviction, Respondent was sentenced to confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice for a period of ten (10) years; however, imposition of the sentence of confinement was suspended, and Respondent was placed on probation for a period of thirty (30) months, with one hundred eighty (180) days jail credit time served, and was ordered to pay court costs.
8. In response to Finding of Fact Number Seven (7), Respondent admits to taking money from Andy Anderson Agency from 2006 to 2008 where she was employed at the time. Respondent attempted to make arrangements with Mr. Anderson to repay the money she had taken and was told he would think about it. Respondent acknowledges what she did in her past is terrible and deeply regrets what she's done. She realizes she cannot trust herself around money and has taken necessary steps to make sure she is never in that situation again.
9. Respondent, by her signature to this Order, expresses her desire to voluntarily surrender her license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation(s) of 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(13).
4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Vocational Nurse License Number 130083, heretofore issued to LISA LYNELL DANNELS, including revocation of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
5. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
6. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, as amended, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
7. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

TERMS OF ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED and ORDERED that the **VOLUNTARY SURRENDER** of Vocational Nurse License Number 130083, heretofore issued to LISA LYNNEL DANNELS, to practice nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing.

In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice vocational nursing, use the title "vocational nurse" or the abbreviation "LVN" or wear any insignia identifying his/herself as a vocational nurse, or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a vocational nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT petition for reinstatement of licensure until one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.


