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ORDER OF MODIFICATION

A public meeting of the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee of the hereinafter referred to as the Committee, was held on September 13, 2016, at 333 Guadalupe, Tower 3, Suite 460, Austin, Texas, to consider the Petition for Exception and supporting documents filed by ANITA MAXINE MITCHELL, hereinafter referred to as PETITIONER.

PETITIONER appeared in person.

After review and due consideration of the filed Petition, the Committee voted to modify the Reinstatement Agreed Order entered on August 6, 2013. Therefore, Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the August 6, 2013, Reinstatement Agreed Order, except that Stipulation Number Eight (8) of that Order, is substituted with the following:

(8) PETITIONER SHALL CAUSE each employer to immediately submit any and all incident, counseling, variance, unusual occurrence, and medication or other error reports involving PETITIONER, as well as documentation of any internal investigations regarding action by PETITIONER, to the attention of Monitoring at the Board's office.

PETITIONER is responsible for completing all remaining requirements of the August 6, 2013, Reinstatement Agreed Order as written in that Order.
