After review and due consideration of the filed Petition, the Committee voted to modify the Agreed Order entered on December 11, 2007. Therefore, Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the December 11, 2007, Agreed Order, except that Stipulation Number Five (5) of that Order, is substituted with the following:

(5) RESPONDENT SHALL CAUSE each employer to immediately submit any and all incident, counseling, variance, unusual occurrence, and medication or other error reports involving

RESPONDENT, as well as documentation of any internal investigations regarding action by RESPONDENT, to the attention of Monitoring at the Board's office.

PETITIONER is responsible for completing all remaining requirements of the December 11, 2007, Agreed Order as written.
