ORDER OF THE BOARD

During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on March 13, 2018, the Texas Board of Nursing Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case, based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license(s) to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by

reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This Order will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing [22 TEX. ADMIN.CODE § 213.16(j)]. All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.

All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Permanent Vocational Nurse License Number 178105, previously issued to ELEANOR DENISE LEE, to practice nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is hereby, REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.

FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, ELEANOR DENISE LEE, is a Vocational Nurse holding License Number 178105, which is in Nurse Licensure Compact - Texas Invalid status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about September 1, 2017, the Voluntary Surrender of Respondent's South Carolina Licensed Vocational Nurse license was accepted by the South Carolina Board of Nursing, Columbia, South Carolina. A copy of the Agreement of Voluntary Surrender from the South Carolina Board of Nursing, dated September 1, 2017, is attached and incorporated by reference as part of this pleading

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(8), and 304.001, Article 5, Texas Occupations Code.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to, and including, revocation of Respondent's license/s to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapters 301 & 304, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 213.27 - 213.33.



VOLUNTARY SURRENDER

I ELEANOR D. LEE have been informed that I am under investigation for alleged violations of South Carolina laws. I have been further informed that I have the right to **VOLUNTARILY SURRENDER** my Nursing license under Section 40- 1 -150 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended; that I do hereby **VOLUNTARILY SURRENDER** my Nursing license and ask the South Carolina Board of Nursing to accept said **VOLUNTARY SURRENDER**. I understand that the voluntary surrender of my Nursing license may not be considered as an admission of guilt by the Board, panel, or court or other entity; that the Board may bring charges against me after proper notice; that I have a right to a hearing; and that I have a right to be represented by legal counsel.

I understand that this voluntary surrender invalidates my Nursing license and, effective immediately, I may not be employed as a nurse and may not represent that I am currently licensed to practice as a nurse.

FURTHER, that I make this Agreement freely and voluntarily and not under duress, restraint or compulsion.
