ORDER GRANTING MODIFICATION

An Agreed Order of the Board was entered on October 26, 2017, for DANIEL CORRAL, Registered Nurse License Number 759165, hereinafter referred to as PETITIONER. PETITIONER filed a Request for Exception to the Agreed Order on October 21, 2019.

A public meeting of the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee of the Board, hereinafter referred to as the Committee, was held on February 11, 2020, at 333 Guadalupe Street, Tower 3, Suite 460, Austin, Texas, to consider the Petition for Exception and supporting documents filed by PETITIONER.

PETITIONER appeared in person.

Board Members in attendance were: David Saucedo, II; Diana Flores, MN, RN; and Allison Porter-Edwards, DrPH, MS, RN, CNE.

After review and due consideration of the file petition, the Committee voted to delay the approval of the request until Petitioner submitted adequate information regarding his employment. On March 25, 2020, Petitioner submitted the requested information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the October 26, 2017, Agreed Order, except that Stipulation(s) Number Six (6), Subsections D-1 is added and E is modified as follows:

**D-1. Incident Reporting for current employer: While under the remaining terms of this Order and employed with HCA, El Paso, Texas, PETITIONER SHALL CAUSE**

each employer to immediately submit any and all incident, counseling, variance, unusual occurrence, and medication or other error reports involving PETITIONER, as well as documentation of any internal investigations regarding action by PETITIONER, to the attention of Monitoring at the Board's office. While employed with HCA, El Paso, Texas, PETITIONER SHALL NOT be required to comply with Paragraph D. If, however, PETITIONER'S employment with HCA, El Paso, Texas, ceases while under the terms of the Order, PETITIONER will be required to comply with Paragraph D for the remainder of the Order, if any, for future employers.

E. PETITIONER SHALL CAUSE each employer to submit, on forms provided to the PETITIONER by the Board, periodic reports as to PETITIONER's capability to practice nursing. These reports shall be completed by the employer, and or individual who supervises the PETITIONER and these reports shall be submitted by the supervising individual and/or employer to the office of the Board at the end of each three (3) month quarterly period for eight (8) quarters [two (2) years] of employment as a nurse

All other terms and conditions of the October 26, 2017, Agreed Order remain unchanged and Petitioner is responsible for complying with those terms as written.
