
You are hereby notified that the Attorney General of Texas has issued an Order Vacating or Staying a

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION
 TO VACATE SUSPENSION OF LICENSE**

The Office of the Attorney General of Texas, Petitioner, filed a Motion to Vacate Suspension of License on July 30, 2009, in the above styled case. Respondent, **TERESA LYNN LOGGINS**, has paid all delinquent child support, has established a satisfactory payment record, or good cause otherwise exists to vacate the Decision and Order, issued September 9, 2008, suspending Respondent's Driver's license, number 12992848, issued by Texas Department of Public Safety and Nursing license, number 00189102, issued by the State Board of Nursing Examiners, the Administrative Law Judge concludes the motion should be granted.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that the Motion to Vacate Suspension of License is **GRANTED**, and the order suspending Respondent's license(s) is **VACATED**.
